



# VIRTUAL CLUB IMPLEMENTATION IDEAS

## QUOTES

- Team Leaders write quotes using chalk and take pictures to send to peers.
- Voice or video recording of quotes to share with peers.
- Write/illustrate a quote on paper and email to peers.
- Send quotes to social media personnel at the location to post on various platforms.
- Create videos and share through classroom management applications (e.g., Schoology).

## SERVICE PROJECT

- Team Leaders ask peers to write quotes on cards/paper and mail to others on their own to brighten their day.
- Team Leaders ask peers to write quotes on cards/paper and mail to the Adviser/location to compile and deliver to a group (like essential workers).
- Team Leaders adopt a nursing home, get the address, and share it with peers - asking them to send letters of cheer (pictures, poems, quotes) to the residents.
- Use sidewalk chalk to write quotes on neighborhood sidewalks to put a smile on the faces of passers-by.
- Following social distancing guidelines, clean up neighborhoods (e.g., pick up trash).
- Organize a virtual fun run/walk with inspiration.

## ACTIVITY GROUPS

- Team Leaders record themselves leading an activity group to share with peers.
- Team Leaders lead a live virtual activity groups.

## KITS

- Advisers drop off kits to students, and Team Leaders explain contents to students virtually.
- Advisers drop off kits to students, and Team Leaders record themselves discussing items in the kit - then send the recording to the student with a greeting.

## TOURS

- Give virtual tours.
- Show the selfie book and give a tour.

## TEAM LEADER MEETINGS

- Hold Team Leader meetings virtually to keep the Team Leaders connected, while gathering ideas to support and inspire their peers.
