

- **ESTABLISHED IN 2015**
- **STARTED AS A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE NAVY AND THE TREVOR ROMAIN COMPANY**
- **PARTNERSHIP HAS EXPANDED TO INCLUDE ALL BRANCHES**
- **NEARLY 400 PARTICIPATING LOCATIONS AND COUNTING**

TRAINING ALLOCATIONS

Funding is provided each year by the sponsoring military branch

Based upon funding, new allocations are trained and current allocations are sustained

New allocations numbers are determined based upon the criteria set by the sponsoring military branch

New allocations are selected by the sponsoring military branch to be trained based upon military population at the location

SELECTING LOCATIONS


- **TIER 1 & 2:**

REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAINING A LOCATION



Selected by the school liaison



Agrees to participate in prep calls



Agrees to participate in training



Keeps positions filled



Implements features



Participate in adviser support



Submits monthly activity reports

POSITIONS TO BE FILLED

Administrative Point of contact – principal or assistant principal/onsite director at youth center

Advisers – any staff member, parent, or volunteer at the location who is involved with the youth on a regular basis

Team Leaders – youth who demonstrate leadership skills and willingness to help others

Crew members/A4L Reps – buddies to provide individualized support

HIGH SCHOOL LEADERSHIP COMMITTEE

Upper classman (11th and 12th grade) selected by the A4L Team Leaders to hold supervisory positions of the club.

- **Secretary**
- **Publicity Officer**

ANCHORED4LIFE TRAININGS (TIER 1)

INITIAL TRAINING

TWO (2) FULL DAYS:

Admin POC attends first three hours of day 1.

Advisers attend both days.

Team Leaders attend day 2.

Informational Overview for all Staff (Max 1 hour)

REFRESHER TRAINING

TWO (2) HOURS: Scheduled around Six (6) Months after initial training.

Advisers

HS – Leadership Committee

FIRST YEAR ONLY

ANNUAL TRAINING

SIX (6) HOURS: Scheduled around one (1) year after initial training.

Advisers – Up to six (6) hours

Team Leaders – Up to four (4) hours



ANCHORED4LIFE MAINTENANCE (TIER 1)

- **THREE (3) HOURS: SCHEDULED ON THE YEAR WHEN A TRAINING IS NOT PROVIDED**
- **ADVISERS – UP TO THREE (3) HOURS**
- **LEADERSHIP COMMITTEE – UP TO THREE (3) HOURS**

ANCHORED4LIFE TIER 2 SUPPORT

INITIAL ORIENTATION

TWO (2) HOURS: Virtual Conference Share about A4L and begin planning implementation.

Advisers

INDIVIDUALIZED CONSULTATION

TWO (2) HOURS: Virtual Conference scheduled between 4-6 months after Initial Orientation.


FIRST YEAR ONLY

ONGOING SUPPORT

TWO (2) HOURS: Virtual Conference Scheduled around one (1) year after Initial Orientation.

SCHOOL LIAISON EXPECTATIONS



Select a location that meets the military branch's criteria requirements



Market to the selected location



Connect location to Anchored4life



Participate in prep calls



Attend – Tier 1 - first full training, then 2 hours of each training thereafter. Tier 2 full session

SCHOOL LIAISON CHECKLIST



Anchored4Life School Liaison Checklist

- School Liaison will attend Anchored4Life orientation and receive access to website.
- Sponsoring military branch will select locations to be trained in Anchored4Life.
- School Liaison will market and publicize Anchored4Life through Military and School channels.
- Once selected, sponsoring military branch will send School Liaison, location's name and address, location's Tier level, and any foreseen implementation obstacles.
- Information Sharing and Introductory Calls are scheduled by Anchored4Life, and School Liaison will attend the scheduled calls.
- When location confirms training dates, Anchored4Life will send an email with training information to location and School Liaison to ensure participation.
- School Liaison will attend the full Tier 1 training (Initial, refresher, annual) or Tier 2 orientation/ongoing support. After attending the full training/orientation/ongoing support, School Liaison will attend the first 2 hours of additional training/orientation/support sessions.
- School Liaison will assist with training logistics, as needed.
- School Liaison will watch the Adviser Support videos, and participate in events and showcases to support participating locations.
- School Liaison will be copied on training emails to ensure participation.
- School Liaison will follow up with locations to determine if any additional support is needed.
- School Liaison will verify receipt of services rendered to a participating location and review orders submitted by participating locations to stay within allocated fund requirements.
- School Liaison will assist location at training in the absence of an Adviser.
- School Liaison will assist location when location is unable to implement the club features or not submitting monthly activity reports.
- School Liaison will continue to share any locations to be trained in Anchored4Life.
- School Liaison will share great ideas, suggestions, and/or concerns with Contractor/Service HQ and Anchored4Life.

SCHOOL LIAISON SUPPORT
