THE ADVISER WILL

- Identify five (5) Team Leaders who will be trained to lead Anchored4Life.
- Obtain signed permission slips (www.a4l.me/mps) for all selected Team Leaders and manage submissions using your login for the Anchored4Life website.
 - Ensure we have photo releases before submitting any photos to Anchored4Life.
- Attend Anchored4Life scheduled training.
- Collaborate with Anchored4Life on implementing the Club.
- Facilitate Anchored4Life Club Features and ensure the structure is in place to support the Team Leaders with implementation.
- Prepare Team Leaders to implement Anchored4Life Club features: Quotes, Tours, Service Projects, Meetings, A4L Kit, and REALTALK.
- Watch Adviser Monthly Support videos.
- Notify Team Leaders of youth in need of support.
- Ensure A4L Reps are utilized at the location.
- Ensure the Anchored4Life Club reviews Showcase Newsletters when published.
- Ensure support and resources are provided to youth experiencing change.
- If awarded a Showcase opportunity, Advisers will collect and send all information to Anchored4Life.
- Order, review, and track Anchored4Life materials.
- Complete and Submit Monthly Activity Reports (MARs) on the LAST day of the month. A MAR is due for all 12 months of a calendar year.
