

Anchored4Life “Chuck Clymer” 2026 Scholarship Application



Anchored4Life “Chuck Clymer” Scholarships are awarded to Anchored4Life Team Leaders during their senior year of High School and have been in Anchored4Life for at least two years. In honor of Chuck Clymer who is dedicated to supporting youth and families. Applications are to be submitted to the Anchored4Life “Chuck Clymer” scholarship committee in May of the year prior to the academic year for which you are requesting support. All information submitted will be held in confidence and used solely for the purpose of scholarship administration.

Instructions:

1. This is a fillable PDF. You will be able to save your work and edit your responses if you use Adobe Acrobat; otherwise must print the application after you have completed it. You may also print the application and fill it out by hand. Make sure your handwriting is legible.
2. Print or type your name and school on each page.
3. Print or type information on Pages 2-4, Personal Data. Do not substitute forms. Minimal additional supplemental information may be accepted.
4. Print or type an essay and include it with your application as directed on page 5. The essay must be original thoughts of the applicant, in the applicant’s own words, written by the applicant.
5. Provide the recommendation instructions to (1) Anchored4Life Admin POC or Adviser, (1) Team Leader and (1) person of your choice as described on page 6 for a total of three recommendations. Recommendations must be printed or typed and included with submission of the full application.
6. Attach a copy of a transcript of your courses. *This transcript must include your high school attendance record. If your transcript does not include your attendance record, please ask your school to provide an official report.*
7. Complete all the information. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
8. Final candidates must be available for a Zoom interview with a member of the scholarship committee. **You will be contacted via email to set up an interview so please check the email you have provided in this application regularly.**
9. Successful applicants will be required to attend the recognition Zoom call.
10. It is suggested that you have your application reviewed by your guidance counselor, individual writing your recommendation, or another person to insure completeness and accuracy.
11. Completed applications are to be submitted by April 27, 2026 to the email below.
