STEP 1

WHAT IS REINTEGRATION?

Reintegration is when you and your special person begin to reconnect after completing a deployment or being away for an extended period of time.

Asking questions allows you to get some answers on how life may look when your special person returns, so you can feel more stable and comfortable in knowing what to expect.

THE SECOND LIFT WAS HOPE. WHY IS HAVING HOPE IMPORTANT?

Hope enables you to stay positive with the expectation that life will get back to normal again. Plans may change but being hopeful that all will work out.
