Make homework a fun habit!

Materials: Worksheets, pencils

Directions: Read the worksheet, complete the activity and discuss with the Group.

Sometimes, we just want to play and forget about doing our homework.

Why? Because playing is more fun!

So, how can we make homework a fun habit? How can we make homework something we always do and want to do, because it's important and we learn interesting things?

We're going to play a game of "swap the homework help."

STEP ONE

On your worksheet, write a question to the Homework Helper asking how to get into the homework habit. Ask about ways to make homework a regular part of your day. For example, "Why should I do my homework?" Or, "What if I don't understand what I'm suppose to do?" Sign your name after writing your question.

STEP TWO

After you've written your question to the Homework Helper, swap it with another youth's letter. This time, you are the Homework Helper! Write the youth's name after "Dear," then answer their question as best you can. Give them some ideas that will help them with their homework.

STEP THREE

When everyone is finished, we will read the questions and answers out loud.
