Individuality rocks!

Materials: Worksheets, colored construction paper, pencils, markers, crayons, stickers, stapler

Directions: Read the worksheet, complete the activity and discuss with the Group.

What is a clique? How do people in cliques act? Do they use the same actions and words? Do they dress alike, walk alike and always stick together?

Sometimes, it's hard to find unique people in a clique, because they all do the same thing.

Ask yourself, "Do you want to blend in and be like everyone else?" Or, "Do you want to stand out as a person with a special character and manners?" Part of being unique is remaining true to who you are and the things you like.

STEP ONE

Using the letters in the alphabet, we're going to describe how to be your own person. We'll go around the room and each person will say the next letter of the alphabet, starting with the letter "A." We'll keep taking turns until all the letters are assigned. Write each of your letters down after you say it, so you won't forget which letters are yours.

When you're finished, we'll collect and staple everyone's pages in alphabetical order to create a booklet. It will be a friendly resource we can all use for how to remain "one of a kind!"
