Materials: Worksheets, pre-cut hanger templates, pencils, markers, crayons

Directions: Read the worksheet, complete the activity and discuss with the Group.

Sometimes, when we need to do our homework, finding a quiet place is difficult. Why? Because others may not understand homework requires focus and concentration. It requires you to pay attention to the assignment and try to do your best work.

Today, we're going to make a "Do not disturb" hanger to use when you're doing homework.

Decorate your hanger and write whatever phrase you like to remind others to be quiet. When everyone is finished, let's share our homework hangers.

Here are some phrases to get you started:

HELPFUL HANGER PHRASES

- Shh! Please do not disturb.
- Brain at work. I need time to think.
- Homework is in session.
- Give me a break! I'm doing my homework.
- Silence is best. I appreciate your help!
- Disturb my thoughts? Don't even think about it.
- Silence is golden... And the golden rule.
- Peace. PLEASE!
- You've entered a Quiet Zone.
- An "A" grade is in progress.
