# Treat others with respect

Materials: Worksheets, pencils, timer  
Directions: Read the worksheet, complete the activity and discuss with the Group.

Most of us appreciate it when other people are kind and polite. When they are courteous and treat us with respect.

What is respect? Respect is treating others in the same way you want to be treated.

But sometimes, people don't treat others respectfully. They behave poorly, often disagree or start fights, and cause others to have hurt feelings.

Let's divide into small groups with no more than four people.

Each group will discuss and decide on at least five respectful ways to treat other people. Pick one person in the group to write your decisions on the worksheet.

Here are some phrases to get you started:

- Choose to say nice things about others.
- Listen to others so we can better understand their thoughts and feelings.
- Show respect by accepting others, even if they are different from us.
- Make new students feel welcome.
- Look out for one another and help when needed.

We'll set the timer for 10 minutes. When the timer sounds, each group will present their ideas.
